Throughout history, women have demonstrated their philanthropic spirit. They have established schools, founded hospitals, and sheltered the homeless, never questioning their ability to make a difference in the world through their donations of time and talent. Today, women are discovering their capacity to transform the world through financial giving.

The Women's Fund of Monterey County's mission is to strengthen community by improving the educational and economic opportunities for women and girls in Monterey County. Founded in 2003, the Fund works with organizations and community-based alliances to make strategic investments in the lives of women and girls. Their intent is to be a model for strategic philanthropy and to empower women to create change through giving.

There are more than 100 women's and girls' funds thriving throughout the United States and abroad. In the last 15 years, they've raised more than \$400 million; in 2001 alone, they raised \$79 million and gave away \$30 million — nearly a third more than in 1999.
